Dear Parent,

This is to inform you that the Telangana State Government has made teaching and learning of **Telugu compulsory in all the schools affiliated to CBSE/ICSE/IB for grade IX.**

“Telugu is to be imparted compulsorily for grade IX in the secondary level in the academic year 2021-22,” as per the proceedings recently issued by the State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT).

On account of this, grade IX students who have opted their II Language as Hindi will be adhering to three language system (English/ II Lang/III Lang) for the academic year 2021-22. The classes for the same will be organized once per week. The schedule for the Telugu classes will be shared shortly.

To facilitate teaching and learning of Telugu in this manner, the SCERT has designed Telugu textbooks for grade IX for the academic year 2021-22 and they will be made available on the SCERT website after they are published.
