Competition	EKTHA RAJA ... EKTHI RANI (Fancy Dress)
Theme	Majestic Kings and Queens of India
Grade	II
Time Allotted	3 minutes (including entry, dialogue and exit)

General Instructions:

1. Participants should be dressed to depict any popular King or Queen of India.
2. Oral presentation on the character in Hindi or English language is mandatory.
3. No recorded aids will be allowed. However, the host school will play a common back-ground score for all participants.
4. Use of props and background decor is allowed.
5. Parent to ensure that the participant has a walking space of at least 10 steps from the camera.

Competition	JANANI JANMABHOOMI (Telugu Poem/Geyam Or Hindi Poem Recitation-SOLO)
Theme	Patriotism
Grade	IV
Time Allotted	3 min (including entry, recitation and exit)

General Instructions:

1. The poem has to be learnt and presented. The participant should not read from any paper or screen.
2. No costumes or props allowed.

Judgement Criteria:

Clarity, Fluency Expression, Pronunciation, Confidence

Competition3

Competition	ANMOL RATAN (Mono Acting)
Theme	Famous Indian Personalities (till the 1950's)
Grade	VI & VII
Time Allotted	3 min (including entry and exit)

General Instructions:

1. Students will dress as any famous Indian personality of the given timeline.
2. They could be artists/authors/poets/sportsmen/dancers/singers/social worker's/film stars (No freedom fighters). A photograph of the personality should be submitted to the host school at least a week ahead through mail and also be presented at the time of competition. (For example- Sarojni Naidu, Rabindranath Tagore, Ashok Kumar, Raja Ravi Varma etc.)
3. Students will either talk/act/sing/speak like the chosen personality within the time limit of 3 min.
4. Students can make a presentation in Hindi OR English. They can use the vernacular language to enhance their presentation in some parts only.

Judgement Criteria:

Accuracy in presentation; Creativity ; Content and Oral Expression;
Body language; Overall impact

Competition4

Competition	BHAJAN BELA (Singing Competition- SOLO)
Theme	Devotional songs in Hindi only
Grade	VII & VIII
Time Allotted	4 minutes (including entry, presentation and exit)

General Instructions:

1. Participants may use Shruti box or Karaoke for support.
2. Students must arrange for their own musical instruments, if needed.
3. Students are required to play musical instruments themselves, if using them. The bhajan must have at least 3 stanzas.

Judgement Criteria:

Rhythm, Tempo, Pronunciation and diction, choice of the song, vocal quality.

Competition 5

Competition	CHEHRE PE CHEHRA (Mask Making Competition)
Theme	Tribes of India
Grade	VII & VIII
Time Allotted	1Hour

General Instructions:

1. Students must arrange for a thick paper (ivory sheet) ,approximately 8 inches in size for the mask.
2. Students must be ready with their colours, paints, glue, feathers, or any other accessories` required to decorate the mask.
3. At no point should the camera be switched off or the participant be not visible to the judges / teachers.

4. The final artwork should be held close to the camera for judges to assess properly and the participant is expected to explain the detailing.

5. A brief oral description about the decorated mask is essential.

Judgement Criteria:

Type of material used (ecofriendly), Detailing & neatness, Creativity, Authenticity, Knowledge of the tribe.

Competition 6

Competition	THIRAK (Folk Dance- SOLO)
Theme	Indian Folk
Grade	VIII-X
Time Allotted	4 minutes

General Instructions:

1. Folk dance of any state of India can be presented.
2. The participant's dance recording has to reach the host school five days before the program day and the participant must introduce himself/herself on the program day.
3. Participants must wear appropriate costume and makeup and have props, if needed
4. Participants must ensure that the background is appropriate and befitting it could be used to enhance the performance.

Judgement Criteria:

Rhythm; Grace & Expression; Authenticity; Costume and Makeup; Choreography.

Competition 7

Competition	PRERNA (Declamation- SOLO)
Theme	Political, Inspirational & Informative (Choose from the topics given)
Grade	IX & X
Time Allotted	3 min (including entry and exit)

General Instructions:

1. Language of speech must be English only
2. Students are required to prepare the speech and present.
3. Students are strictly not allowed to read from any source during the competition.
4. The Declamation could follow this general structure:
5. Introduction —30 sec — student delivers the introduction
6. Main Body of Speech 2 minutes — student delivers the main points of the speech
7. Conclusion of Speech — 30 seconds — student wraps up the speech

Time Allotted	Round 1 - 10 minutes Top 4 teams will compete in Round 2

General Instructions:

1. Google form will be used for the Preliminary Round. Top teams will proceed to Round 2.
2. Round 2 will include audio, visual rapid fire and other rounds that deal with our rich heritage and traditions— built. natural , customs & traditions , personalities etc.,
3. Rules will be explained two days before to all the participating teams .
4. Participants to ensure the optimum audio and video clarity of the device in use. They should be visible at all times. We trust all not to indulge in any malpractices.

Competition 9

Competition	CHITRAKALA (Art Competition)
Theme	Paint or sketch any monument of India.
Grade	IX & X
Time Allotted	1 Hour

General Instructions:

1. A-3 size drawing sheet must be used.
2. Poster colours and sketching pencils will be allowed.
3. Participants must arrange their own colours, paint brushes, stationery etc.
4. All participants are expected to mention the name and show the picture of their monument before they begin.
5. The picture can be kept in front at all times.
6. Cameras must be switched on at all times ensuring that the participants are visible while at work. They can be asked to show their sheet from time to time.
