Maths Basic Or Maths Standard - Class 10

CBSE will conduct two form of Maths Exams for Class 10 Boards - Maths Basic and Maths Standard

Maths Basic is for students who do not want to pursue Maths in Class 11 and 12.

While Maths Standard is compulsory for students who want to take up Maths in Class 11, 12 and College

The Maths Basic Exam is **easier** than the Maths Standard Exam.

Choose **Maths Standard** if you want to

- Take Commerce with Maths in Class 11 and 12
- Take Science in Class 11 and 12
- Give IIT-JEE or Medical Exams (NEET)
- To do any Engineering course after Class 12
- To do CA, CS after Class 12
- Want to go to Medical Field after Class 12

Choose **Maths Basic** if you want to

- Take arts in Class 11 and 12
- Take Commerce without Maths in Class 11 and 12
- Take any non-maths course after Class 12 - like Design, Animation, Humanities

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Are there two exams for Maths now?

Ans: No, students can choose between Maths Basic, or Maths Standard. Both the papers will be held on the same day.

2. Is the Syllabus same in both Maths Basic and Maths Standard?

Ans: Yes, the Syllabus of Maths Basic and Maths Standard exam will be the same.

3. What is difference in Maths Basic and Maths Standard?

Ans: The Maths Basic Exam is much easier than Maths Standard Exam.

4. Can a student opt for both - Maths Basic and Maths Standard?

Ans: No. Student can only solve 1 exam. She/he has to choose between - Maths Basic and Maths Standard

5. Why do I choose Maths Standard over Maths Basic? The Basic one is easier

Ans: If you want to take up Maths in Class 11 and Class 12. Then take Maths Standard. If you are sure you won't study Maths in the future, take Maths Basic.

6. What if I give the Basic Exam now, but want to appear for Standard Exam later?

Ans: If after giving the exam, you realise that you should have given the Standard Exam... then there's an option. You can give the **Maths Standard Compartment Exam**

7. What if the child fails in the exam?

There is an option to give Compartment Exams.

Failed in	Compartment Options
Mathematics - Basic	Mathematics - Basic
Mathematics - Standard	Mathematics - Standard or Mathematics - Basic

So, you can give Maths Basic Compartment Exam if you fail in Maths Standard

8. What about the internal assessment of 20 marks?

Maths Exam is of total 100 marks, out of which 20 marks are internal assessment.

These 20 marks are for

- Internal Exams (10 Marks)
- Lab Report (5 Marks)
- Activities (5 marks)

These 20 marks are the same for both Maths Basic and Maths Standard.
