<b>Grades 1-4</b>	<b>Diya decoration Competition</b>	Diyas, sparklers, Paint colors, beads, Kundans, Fevicol or glue (Materials of their choice and availability)
<b>Grades 5 -6</b>	<b>Paper Lantern making competition</b>	Colour papers, Sketch pens, strings, Scissors, Fevicol or glue, Decorative materials(Materials of their choice and availability)
<b>Grades 7-8 (Girls)</b>	<b>Flower rangoli competition</b>	Flowers of choice, Diyas for decoration, (Materials of their choice and availability) Interpretation of the theme Level of creativity and originality, quality of the artwork and artistic skill to be demonstrated.
<b>Grades 7-8 (Boys)</b>	<b>Flameless cooking</b>	Participants should not bring any pre-cooked items. All the items required for cooking should be brought by the participants themselves. They should prepare the food item on the spot within allotted time of 30-45 minutes. They are supposed to display a chart having the name of the dish, ingredients and calorie count of the dish prepared.
